Matters Arising

The Treasurer reported that following the last meeting he had again contacted HSBC business banking and after both he and the Secretary had spoken to their representatives the issues affecting our bank account have been resolved. Further confirmation was provided following a visit to the local branch by the Treasurer, where he was advised to allow things to settle for a couple of months before we add additional signatories.

Chairman's Report

The Chairman reported that we have now used nine of the twelve available dates at Albemarle Barracks and that following initial problems the new automated booking system appears to be working correctly with the last request being approved within twenty-four hours. Details of the booking also seem to be getting to the right people with the guardroom being aware of the booking in advance of Martin checking that all was ok in the week before. There was a minor problem at the last event on 30th July when a country member turned up without proof of membership to watch the control line flying but was not intending to fly. The control line fliers present agreed to look after him as a guest, but members are reminded that they should be carrying proof of membership regardless of whether they are flying or not, and should report to the key orderly on arrival, particularly if flying control line and should not head straight to the sports field. Concerns about members driving on the active runway on arrival or departure were raised by Euan Galloway (Area 51) and Gerard Gaynor, there is no simple solution to the problem as if those heading to or leaving the sports field drive around the perimeter track then the key orderly either has to drive down to them to check membership cards, or to verify they have all left before arranging for the access gate to be

locked. The chairman suggested obtaining some temporary signs to place on the active runway or perimeter track to direct traffic away from the active runway, it was agreed that this could be a possible solution and Martin is to look at what is available and report at the next meeting. The secretary was asked to have a look at the guidance notes for Albemarle and amend them to reflect what is expected of attendees.

Secretary's Report

The Secretary reported that he had been contacted by Nick Powley (Eden Valley MAC) regarding the replacement of the cheque we sent them to support their Aero-tow event. As the issues with HSBC Bank have been resolved as reported in "matters arising" the replacement will be issued following the meeting and forwarded to their Treasurer. Gary also reported that he had been contacted by Apian Airspace regarding an airspace change request that they are proposing to submit to the CAA to establish a TDA (Temporary Danger Area) to the north of Newcastle to allow trials of drone deliveries to an assortment of NHS establishments. The area covered will affect several clubs in the area and whilst both the BMFA and LMA are included in the stakeholder list being contacted for feedback there are a number of clubs that may be impacted. Gary is to circulate the proposal and feedback form to those clubs concerned so that they can respond directly.

Treasurers Report

As reported earlier the issues with HSBC have been resolved and the replacement cheques for Eden Valley MAC and those control line pilots representing the UK at the European Championships can now be issued if required. Tom also reported the current state of the area finances with a number of cheques not yet presented.

Delegates Report

The Area Delegate reported that the next Area Council meeting is due to be held on 14th September via Zoom, but as yet the agenda has not been published. He also confirmed that comments received from Area clubs about "rolling" BMFA membership had been uploaded to the Area Council forum.

Achievement Scheme Controllers Report

Due to total lack of interest from clubs within the Area the ASC reluctantly announced that the Area Training & Testing Day at Albemarle on 3rd September was cancelled as it was not fair to ask our Area Chief Examiners to travel long distances to attend if there were no candidates for them to test or train. The date was offered to other clubs and Peterlee RMC have taken it on as a general R/C flying day, should anyone want to take a test then the ASC will be available to attend as long as he is notified in advance.
