Chairman's Report

No report was received from the Chairman who was on holiday.

Secretary's Report

The Secretary reported that he had received the licence to use Albemarle Barracks for the next twelve months, unfortunately there has been a 50% increase in the licence fee from £400.00 to £600.00. Gary had queried the amount with the DIO but was informed that it is the military at Albemarle that set the fee and that it was in line with what other groups that use the base are paying. With the cost of preparing the licence at £150.00 plus VAT and a £30.00 insurance charge the total amount payable is £810.00, with the invoice expected in the next few days. The booking for Sunday 10th March was confirmed by the guardroom on Monday 4th March, with some training taking place on the day we were asked to check with the guardroom when ringing to get the gate opened to see if any areas of the airfield were unavailable to us.

The Secretary apologised for the late distribution of the February meeting minutes and confirmed that in accordance with those minutes the informal verbal warning had been sent

to the member concerned via email. Gary also confirmed that he had submitted a funding request to the Hon. Treasurer along with a draft budget showing what we expect to spend in the coming year. Given the funds we already have which include monies received last year for events that didn't take place it is unlikely that we will receive anything other than the base funding of £600.00, and even that may not be forthcoming. Gary also reported that he had set up a test of the bulk email facility but had not yet sent anything out due to a lack of time. Finally, the plan to arrange a meeting with the new commanding officer at Albemarle is on hold until the Chairman is back from his holiday.

Treasurers Report

The Treasurer reported the current state of the Area's finances and outlined payments and receipts since the last meeting. The payments to clubs that we have agreed to provide with event support will be sorted following the meeting but will not be despatched until the clubs concerned have provided the necessary advertising material for the area website as per our terms and conditions. As agreed at the AGM the paperwork to add the Chairman as an additional signatory on the Area bank account has been prepared and just needs the Chairman to visit his local branch with proof of ID to complete the process.

The next Areas Council meeting is on 9th May, the agenda for the meeting is not expected until sometime in April.
